

Qualifying Sizes and State Records

Note: These are Big Catch and State Record sizes—not regulated sizes.



Catch all four species of bass in a one-year period for a Black Bass Slam! Largemouth bass 8 lbs and larger may qualify for FWC's TrophyCatch program (see TrophyCatchFlorida.com).





The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission provides three freshwater angler recognition programs. Register, submit catches, print your certificates and claim prizes at TrophyCatchFlorida.com.



Big Catch encourages fishing for a diversity of species and includes both adult and youth categories. A simple photo of the fish exceeding the specified minimum length or weight is all that is needed. Native fish and peacock bass may be kept or released according to applicable rules; however, other non-native fishes should be harvested and are edible. Big Catch also provides recognition for Specialists, Master Anglers, Elite Anglers and catching Black Bass, Bream or Non-Native Slams. TrophyCatch requires more documentation but provides bigger rewards.

State records must be witnessed by an FWC biologist and weighed on certified scales. Learn more on the website when you register.



TrophyCatch is a special program that rewards anglers for catching, documenting and releasing largemouth bass heavier than eight pounds. Help conserve these valuable fish and reward yourself by being able to say "My Trophy Swims in Florida."
